

#### Checklist

#### Dresscode

**Jacket** (neutral colours)

> **Collared Dress Shirt** (white or light-coloured)

Tie (optional but encouraged)

**Suit Pants / Chinos** (neutral colours)

**Dress Shoes** (matching with belt colour; black, brown)



**Jacket / Pant Suit** (neutral colours)

Collared Dress Shirt / **Blouse** 

(white or light-coloured) or **Dress** 

(knee length)

**Suit Pants / Chinos** 

(neutral colours)

or

Skirt

(knee length)

**Closed-Toe Shoes** (pumps, flats)

### **Position Paper Guidelines**

These guidelines apply to committees only. For Press guidelines, see Press BGG.

Position Papers are not mandatory at MainMUN but highly encouraged.

- Deadline: 26.02.2025
- Submission on mymun.com via "My Application"
- Formatting:
  - 1 Page per Topic
  - o Font: Arial, Size: 12pt, Spacing: 1-1.5
  - No Citations
  - O Use of Artificial Intelligence not allowed!

#### Content for each topic:

- 1. Paragraph: Introduction of the topic itself
- 2. Paragraph: International Achievements regarding topic (i. e. UN resolutions, treaties, etc.)
- 3. Paragraph: Your Member State's contributions to the topic
- 4. Paragraph: Outline your Member State's Goals, specific actions to resolve the topic
- Tip: Remember that position papers are written from the perspective of your Member State. Always stay in character (e.g. you do not have to mention resolutions that your Member State doesn't support)
